

HOLOCAUST REMEMBRANCE WEEK JANUARY 23-27

With the passage of Senate Bill 1828 in the fall of 2019, the Texas legislature officially created an annual Holocaust Remembrance Week in public schools.

This week was created to "educate students about the Holocaust and inspire in students a sense of responsibility to recognize and uphold human value and to prevent future atrocities." Bowie will observe Holocaust Remembrance Week January 23-January 27.

In addition to daily morning announcements from the Dallas Holocaust and Human Rights Museum, English and Social Studies teachers will facilitate Holocaust lessons with their classes.

Holocaust survivor and member of the Texas Holocaust and Genocide Commission, Lucy Katz, will also be inperson at Bowie, working with specific classes to better understand the scope of the Holocaust.
