NEW CHROME BOOK POLICY AND HOURS

Austin ISD is a 1:1 district, meaning every student is provided with a free Chromebook. To ensure they are ready for learning and to take digital assessments, students must bring their fully charged Chromebook or personal device to school every day.

Bowie is no longer able to provide loaner Chromebooks for the day should students leave theirs at home. We are currently looking to hire a clerk who will manage Chromebooks among other responsibilities.

Until a new clerk is hired and regular support hours are resumed, Chromebook help will be available M-F immediately before school, during FIT, and during the first 15-minutes of lunch in the A117 Bookroom to those students needing to swap out a broken Chromebook or replace a lost charger (click [HERE](#) for more Chromebook information and resources).
