

Congratulations to the four individual awards: **Finn Alexander**- All Star Cast, **Lucy Evans**- All Star Cast, **Megan Sewell**- Honorable Mention and **Nadia Petru** - Outstanding Technician.

The company's next competition took top honors at the Bi-District contest in Round Rock, taking 1st place and advancing to Area contest in San Antonio next week. Congratulations to **Megan Sewell** - Outstanding Performer Award, **Jadon Demetri** - All-Star Cast award, **Lainey Killian** - Honorable Mention award and **Owen Aleman** - Outstanding Technician Award.

And, for the second time this year, we took the Outstanding Technical Crew Award. The crew includes **Nadia Petru**, **Owen Aleman**, **Jake Johnson**, **Peyton Brunner**, **Nate Motes**.

Two entries are going to State in the UIL Theatrical Design competition.
